






Letter of Acceptance will be sent to the qualified students before:

- April 31 (for the first semester) or
- September 31 (for the second semester)

### **REQUIRED DOCUMENTS**

- Application form (download from http://www.siit.tu.ac.th/crd)
- Resume
- Transcript of records
- English Proficiency Test score (TOFEL / IELTS, or an equivalent)
- Recommendation letter from an academic adviser
- 3 one-inch photos (taken within 6 months)
- A copy of passport
